### **Reviewer's Comment for Publication.**

It unveils the relationship between challenges in managing emotions such as frustration, anxiety, or sadness and academic motivation, highlighting how these difficulties can affect a teenager's academic tasks. It offers valuable insights and meaningful contribution to scholarly discourse in this area, and underscores the need for further research.

# **Detailed Reviewer's Report**

Below are my comments:

- **1.** The objective of the study needs to be briefly and clearly stated in the abstract. This is obviously missing. I suggest the author/s include this in the abstract.
- **2.** I suggest you avoid including citations in the abstract as abstract is author's brief summary of her/his work. I suggest you consider removing the citations and rephrase the entire paragraph.
- **3.** For APA referencing style, remove initials in all in-text citations. For instance, in line 31 you cited (Jaworska, N., & MacQueen, G., 2015). Remove initials put only surnames and the year of publication.
- **4.** In line 56, 'Cuceloglu (2005) (as cited in Uyulgan, Melis & Akkuzu Güven, 56 Nalan, 2014)'. I suggest you remove "as cited in Uyulgan, Melis & Akkuzu Güven, Nalan, 2014".
- **5.** The literature/sources cited in the study are quite insufficient. There are a lot more sources to engage with to give the study more depth. A study of this nature requires a good assemblage of relevant literature to support ideas and findings and for stronger theoretical background.
- 6. The study relies mostly on sources over 5 years. This is not very satisfactory for a study of this nature. There have been numerous recent developments/studies in this area of interest It is important that a study of this nature relies majorly on recent studies and theoretical insights.

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- 7. Author/s need to clearly explain what criteria informs the choice of age of the teenagers (15-18). Also, why the choice of purposive sampling over other sampling methods.
- **8.** The author/s need to explain why the choice of private schools and exclusion of government schools.
- **9.** The author/s should explain clearly what informs the methodological orientation of the study as this is not strongly stated.
- **10.** It will be important as well to highlight any methodological gap in previous studies in this area. In line with the above, author/s should crosscheck and restructure the methodology section of the study.
- **11.** The pages of the manuscript are not numbered. This makes reading the manuscript a bit difficult. The author/s need to consider inserting page numbers.
- **12.** Author/s should crosscheck style, citation, (reference/bibliography) according to Author Guidelines for formatting, citing, and referencing provided by the journal.
