2 Utility of mental state in prescribing homoeopathic medicine – A

3 case report of tension type headache

- 4 Abstract Headache is the most common problem for which patient wants medical attention as it
- 5 is decreasing the quality of life of person. TTH is a chronic head pain syndrome which is
- 6 characterized by bilateral tight band like discomfort without any associated features i.e. nausea,
- 7 vomiting, photophobia, phonophobia and aggravate with movements.
- 8 Mental state is a situation that exists in organisms at all levels and in different area in response to
- 9 certain stimuli (past as well as present) and is expressed in a qualitative manner through the
- 10 functioning of organism. According to Dr. Hahnemann, Headache is one sided disease in which
- we get very few symptoms for getting similimum. So, mental state of patient during headache is
- very helpful for getting similimum.

- 20 Primary headache It is mainly benign headache i.e. all examination and investigation are
- 21 normal. Causes of primary headache Migraine, Tension type headache, cluster headache
- 22 Secondary headache In this all examination and investigation are not normal and it is due to
- some central nervous system (CNS) disease for ex-subarachnoid hemorrhage, severe
- 24 hypertension, meningitis, sinusitis etc.
- Out of primary headache tension type headache is most common form of headache. Age and
- 26 gender is a risk factor for tension type headache as it is maximum in females of reproductive age

- 27 group with a ratio of around 1:1.2 to 1:3 between male and female. For school going children,
- age group is between 7 and 15 years.

- 40C. At least two of the following four characteristic:
- 411. Bilateral location
- 422. Pressing or tightening (non pulsating) quality
- 433. Mild to moderate intensity
- 444. Not aggravated by routine physical activity such as walking or climbing stairs
- 45D. Both of the following
- 461. No nausea and vomiting
- 472. More than one of the photophobia or no phonophobia

- 80 Hahnemann classified headache as one sided disease with internal complaints.


