# Detailed Reviewer's Report

### **Strengths:**

- 1. Timely Relevance: The manuscript aligns well with the current academic discourse on integrating indigenous knowledge with modern curricula, especially as emphasized in NEP 2020.
- 2. Comprehensive Coverage: The paper explores diverse domains of IKS, mathematics, medicine, philosophy, arts, linguistics, etc., in a balanced and structured manner.
- 3. Strong Historical and Philosophical Grounding: The paper references ancient texts like the Vedas, Upanishads, Natyashastra, and Ashtadhyayi with appropriate context and clarity.
- 4. Contemporary Application: It connects ancient knowledge with present-day educational needs such as ethical grounding, holistic development, and innovation in science and technology.
- 5. Well-Cited and Researched: References are academically sound, including both classical and modern sources relevant to IKS and education policy.

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### Weaknesses:

- 1. Lack of Primary Evidence: The paper is largely conceptual and would benefit from examples of recent institutional implementations (e.g., case studies of IKS-based programs).
- 2. **Language and Flow**: At times, the writing is overly dense. Simplifying and breaking down longer paragraphs could improve readability.
- 3. **Overgeneralization**: Some claims (e.g., on the superiority or universality of IKS) need to be qualified or supported by academic sources.
- 4. **Formatting Issues**: Subheadings are not consistently formatted. Some sentences have typographical errors or awkward phrasing.
- 5. **Missing Policy Analysis**: Though NEP 2020 is mentioned, a more analytical reflection on its limitations or implementation challenges would enhance the manuscript.
