Strengths:

Areas for Improvement:

1. **Technical Depth:** While the paper outlines applications of AI, it lacks sufficient depth in technical explanation. Adding specific examples, case studies, or data-driven evidence would strengthen the technical quality.
2. **Literature Support:** The discussion would benefit from the inclusion of more references to recent studies (2020–2025) to validate claims.
3. **Formatting and Consistency:** Some sections contain long paragraphs that could be broken down for better readability. Additionally, ensure consistency in headings and sub-headings for smooth flow.
4. **Critical Perspective:** While the manuscript emphasizes benefits, a more balanced critique of AI risks (bias, data privacy, job displacement) should be expanded with real-world examples.

Overall, the manuscript is promising and relevant for publication, but revisions are recommended to enhance its academic quality and credibility.

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
