- 1. The abstract presents the topic well, with appropriate attention to the link between ASD, inflammation, and dermatologic comorbidities.
- 2. Add a sentence about methodology if any original analysis, review framework, or case data were used.
- 3. Include a clear aim or objective at the end of the introduction.
- 4. Consider clearly delineating the information into separate subheadings.
- 5. The manuscript does not specify whether this is literature review or a narrative review or a case series.
- 6. The review references several studies but lacks consistent citation, formatting and occasionally fails to elaborate on study quality (sample sizes, study design).
- 7. Some paragraphs are overly long and could be split to aid clarity.
- 8. Communication barriers, sensory sensitivities, and provider limitations are well-documented.
- 9. For clinical recommendations, strengthen the section with a table of practical clinical tips or a summary box.
- 10. Clearly mention these subheadings; add title, conclusion, and methods section.
