### Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

This article reports a rare case of a median palatine cyst, a non-odontogenic cyst caused by epithelial remnants trapped during fetal development. A 40-year-old male presented with a painless swelling in the mid-palate. Diagnosis was done through CBCT and aspiration. The cyst was surgically removed under local anesthesia. Histology confirmed the diagnosis. Follow-up after six months showed complete healing with no recurrence.

### Strengths:

1. Focuses on a rare and clinically significant condition.
2. Provides clear clinical, radiographic, and histopathological details.
3. Includes step-by-step surgical management and follow-up.
4. Supported with literature references and diagnostic criteria.

### Weaknesses:

1. Single case report; results cannot be generalized.
2. Limited discussion on alternative treatments and prevention.
3. Minimal long-term follow-up beyond six months.

### Overall Assessment:

A well-presented and informative case report highlighting an unusual oral cyst. It emphasizes the importance of imaging, histology, and proper surgical management. The article adds value for oral surgeons and clinicians dealing with rare palatal cysts.
