Strengths

Suggestions for Minor Revision

1. **Language and Style** – A light copyedit to correct minor grammatical issues (e.g., article usage, occasional run-on sentences) would improve readability.
2. **Figures** – Ensure that the PSA and Free PSA trend figures are clearly labeled with axis titles and units, and embedded with adequate resolution for publication.
3. **Conclusion Section** – Condense slightly to avoid repetition of earlier discussion points while keeping the key clinical lessons clear.

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Conclusion

The case adds valuable evidence to the literature on PSA interpretation and metastatic CRPC management. With these minor adjustments, the manuscript is suitable for publication.
