- 3. **Referencing:** The references lack proper formatting consistency. Standardized citation styles should be adopted and uniformly applied throughout the paper.
- 4. **Grammatical and Typographical Errors:** Minor errors, such as inconsistent tense usage and minor typographical mistakes, are present and should be addressed.
- 5. **Figures and Tables:** The manuscript would benefit from the inclusion of diagrams or tables to illustrate the anatomy, physiology, and pathophysiology described, aiding visual comprehension.

Recommendations for the Author:

- 1. Refine language and sentence structure to enhance clarity and readability.
- 2. Standardize references according to a consistent citation style (e.g., Vancouver or APA).
- 3. **Proofread thoroughly** to correct minor grammatical and typographical errors.
