## Detailed Reviewer's Report

### General Assessment

The manuscript presents a rare and clinically significant case of acute pyelonephritis leading to acute kidney injury in an adolescent with newly diagnosed diabetes mellitus. The case is well-documented and contributes meaningfully to the clinical understanding of atypical infectious presentations in undiagnosed diabetic patients. The writing is concise, and the sequence of diagnosis, intervention, and outcome is logically presented.

### Suggestions for Improvement

**Title:-** The phrase Killer picket in carpenter is ambiguous. A more medically descriptive title such as A Rare Case of Acute Pyelonephritis Leading to Acute Kidney Injury in an Undiagnosed Diabetic Adolescent may improve clarity and professional appeal.

**Figures:-** Ensure all clinical images are of high resolution and appropriately labeled (A, B, C, D) with clear captions and patient confidentiality maintained.

**Literature Support:-** Consider including more recent references (past 5 years) on acute pyelonephritis in diabetic patients to strengthen the discussion.

**Language and Grammar:-** Minor typographical and spacing corrections (e.g. missing spaces in givenin view, tuned out to be) are recommended for smoother readability.

**Table Presentation:-** Tables 1 and 2 could be formatted more compactly for clarity—avoid excessive line spacing and align parameters neatly for easier comparison.

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### Scientific Merit

The case adds valuable insight into the early manifestation of diabetes through severe infection and emphasizes the importance of prompt management to prevent irreversible renal damage. It aligns with current clinical relevance and could serve as a teaching case for medical trainees.
