Detailed Reviewer's Report

Strengths of the Paper

- **Clear Focus on a Rare but Important Complication:** The paper addresses the uncommon but potentially life-threatening issue of textiloma migration into the intestine, emphasizing its clinical significance.
- **Use of Multimodal Imaging Analysis:** Detailed descriptions of imaging findings, especially CT features, provide valuable diagnostic insights for clinicians.
- **Illustrative Case Presentation:** The inclusion of a specific case with imaging and surgical findings enhances understanding and illustrates real-world application.
- **Comprehensive Literature Review:** The references cited span relevant previous reports, aiding in contextualizing the case within existing knowledge.
- **Emphasis on Diagnostic and Surgical Management:** The discussion highlights the critical role of imaging in diagnosis and surgical intervention, offering practical guidance.

Weaknesses of the Paper

- **Limited Detail on Methodology:** The article presents a single case without elaborate information on patient selection criteria or detailed surgical procedures.
- **Insufficient Discussion on Long-term Outcomes:** There is little information on postoperative follow-up or long-term prognosis of such cases.
- **Lack of Visual Aids:** The absence of actual imaging figures or intraoperative photographs diminishes the illustrative quality.
- **Inconsistent Citation Style:** References are numbered without uniform formatting, which could impact clarity.
- **Minimal Explanation of Differential Diagnoses:** While some differential considerations are mentioned, a more comprehensive discussion would strengthen the diagnostic context.

Reviewer Comments

- **Ethical Clearance Status:** The paper does not mention whether ethical approval or patient consent was obtained, which is necessary for case reports.
- **Issues in Methodology:** As a case report, detailed procedural or diagnostic methodology is lacking; including a description of the diagnostic process and surgical approach would improve clarity.
- **Typographical Mistakes:** Minor typographical issues are present, such as inconsistent spacing and occasional typographical errors in references.

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- **Grammar and English Language Quality:** Overall, the language is clear, though some sentences could benefit from grammatical refinement for fluency.
- **Formatting Issues:** The manuscript could be improved by standardizing heading styles, ensuring consistent font size, and including clear figure legends if images are added.
- **Clarity of Objectives, Results, and Conclusion:** The objectives and findings are generally clear; however, explicitly stating the aim at the beginning and summarizing key findings in a dedicated section would enhance clarity.
- **Adequacy of References:** The references cover relevant literature, but their formatting is inconsistent, and some key recent studies might be missing.
- **Missing or Incomplete Information:** Additional details on the patient's postoperative course, follow-up, and any preventive measures to avoid future incidents should be included. Also, images or diagrams illustrating the imaging findings would enrich the manuscript.
