### Detailed Reviewer's Report

#### Strengths of the Paper

- **Relevant Clinical Focus:** The paper addresses an important and challenging issue in obstetric and rheumatologic care-managing thrombocytopenia in pregnant women with systemic lupus erythematosus.
- **Comprehensive Case Detail:** The case report provides detailed clinical presentation, laboratory findings, and management steps, which can serve as a valuable reference for clinicians.
- **Emphasis on Multidisciplinary Care:** The discussion highlights the importance of coordinated management involving obstetricians, rheumatologists, and transfusion specialists, emphasizing best practices in complex cases.
- **Integration of Literature:** The references cited are pertinent and provide context for the case, supporting the discussion points effectively.

#### Weaknesses of the Paper

- **Insufficient Methodological Clarity:** The report does not specify detailed diagnostic criteria, investigation protocols, or management algorithms used, reducing reproducibility.
- **Lack of Ethical Approval Discussion:** The manuscript does not mention whether ethical approval or patient consent was obtained, which is essential in case reports.
- **Formatting and Citation Inconsistencies:** References and footnotes are poorly organized, which detracts from the professionalism and readability of the manuscript.
- **Limited Analytical Discussion:** The report primarily describes the case without exploring alternative management strategies or analyzing risks and benefits thoroughly.
- **Objective Clarity:** The aims and specific outcomes are implied but not explicitly stated at the beginning or in the conclusion, which could improve clarity.
- **Limited Follow-up Data:** The report does not include long-term maternal or fetal follow-up information, which would enhance understanding of outcomes.

#### Reviewer Comments

- **Ethical Clearance:** The manuscript does not mention whether ethical approval or informed consent was obtained. For case reports, declaring patient consent and institutional approval is usually necessary and should be explicitly stated.

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## REVIEWER'S REPORT

- **Methodology Issues:** The diagnostic criteria, laboratory investigations, and treatment protocols lack detail. Clarification of how the diagnosis was established and monitored would strengthen the case report.
- **Typographical Mistakes:** Minor typographical errors are present, such as inconsistent numbering and spacing issues, which should be corrected.
- **Grammar and Language:** The language is generally clear but could benefit from tighter editing to improve professionalism and readability.
- **Formatting Issues:** The references and footnotes are not well formatted; aligning them with journal standards would improve presentation. The headings and subheadings could also be better organized.
- **Clarity of Objectives, Results, and Conclusions:** The goals and outcomes are inferred rather than explicitly stated. Clearly articulating the case objectives, management outcomes, and key takeaways would enhance clarity.
- **References:** The references are relevant but lack uniform formatting. Including complete reference details and ensuring consistency would strengthen the manuscript.
- **Missing or Incomplete Information:** Details such as prior health status, specific management protocols, and long-term follow-up data are missing but could be valuable for comprehensive understanding.
