Reviewer's Comment for Publication.

This study evaluates the effect of a self-care nursing protocol on patients with ureteric double J stents. Using a quasi-experimental design, the study compares a study group receiving structured self-care education with a control group receiving routine care. Results show that patients who followed the self-care protocol had better knowledge, improved self-care practices, fewer symptoms, and fewer complications.

Strength:

1. Clear aim and well-defined objectives
2. Appropriate quasi-experimental design
3. Use of validated and reliable tools
4. Statistically significant results
5. Strong role of nursing intervention highlighted

Weakness:

1. Single-center study
2. Moderate sample size
3. Follow-up period is relatively short
4. Language and formatting need minor improvement

Overall assessment:

The article is well-designed and clinically relevant. It shows strong evidence that self-care education improves patient outcomes. The study is suitable for publication after minor revisions, mainly related to language clarity and presentation.
