Minor revisions are therefore recommended to improve conciseness and readability. Specifically, some descriptive sections (vision, scope, metrics, and post-implementation considerations) can be condensed, overlapping explanations reduced, and appendices selectively summarized. Language refinement and consistency in formatting will further enhance academic presentation.

Overall, the manuscript makes a valuable applied contribution to digital transformation and change management literature in construction management. Subject to minor revisions focusing mainly on length reduction and editorial refinement, the paper is suitable for publication.
