## *Detailed Reviewer's Report*

### General Assessment

This manuscript presents a well-documented and clinically significant case report describing an exceptional therapeutic response in a relatively young patient with locally advanced, inoperable HPV 16/p16-positive vulvar carcinoma. The topic is relevant, timely, and contributes valuable insight into multimodal management strategies for rare and challenging gynecologic malignancies. The manuscript is generally well written, logically structured, and supported by appropriate imaging, clinical follow-up, and literature context.

### Originality

The case is rare due to the patient's relatively young age, HPV-associated tumor biology, advanced T4N1M0 staging, and the dramatic response to induction chemotherapy followed by concurrent chemoradiotherapy. The multimodal approach and outcome add originality and educational value.

- Add a short paragraph on long-term surveillance strategy and anticipated late toxicities.

**2. Ethical Statement Placement:**

- The consent and conflict of interest statements are appropriate but could be consolidated into a single standardized “Ethics and Consent” section, as per many journal guidelines.

**Minor Comments**

1. Perform careful language and formatting editing to improve consistency and readability.
2. Ensure uniform abbreviation usage throughout the manuscript (e.g=., PET-CT, MRI, I-MRT).
3. Verify reference formatting consistency according to journal style.
