### *Detailed Reviewer's Report*

This bibliometric analysis provides a comprehensive and methodologically sound review of scientific literature on sustainable strategies for coexistence between pastoralism and wildlife conservation in biosphere reserves. The study is well-structured, employs robust analytical techniques (PICO model, R bibliometric package), and identifies key trends, including the conceptual shift from exclusionary to integrative paradigms and the emergence of regenerative management approaches. The findings on geographical research imbalances and the need for transdisciplinary approaches are particularly valuable.

For minor revision, please address the following: 1) Correct the inconsistent timeframe; the abstract and methodology state data spans "1966-2026," yet analyses and figures (e.g., Fig. 1) only extend to 2024. Clarify the actual final year of data collection. 2) Enhance the discussion of geographical disparities by briefly suggesting concrete mechanisms to rebalance research capacity (e.g., equitable partnerships, targeted funding). 3) Ensure all figures and tables cited in the text (Figs. 2-6, Table 2) are included and correctly referenced in the submission package. 4) In the conclusion, briefly elaborate on one or two specific, actionable recommendations for policymakers or reserve managers derived from the dominant thematic clusters. These refinements will strengthen the manuscript's clarity, accuracy, and practical relevance.
