### Detailed Reviewer's Report

#### 1. Originality

##### Recommendation:

The originality of the manuscript is strong and acceptable. However, the authors are encouraged to explicitly highlight the novelty of the ZIS-based education financing model in comparison with existing education financing frameworks (state budget-based or conventional philanthropic models) in the introduction or conclusion to further strengthen the contribution.

#### 2. Technical Quality

##### Recommendation:

The technical quality is generally sound. Minor revisions are recommended to:

- Improve the analytical depth by reducing repetitive descriptive sections.
- Strengthen the linkage between theoretical concepts and empirical or policy implications.
- Ensure consistency in methodological explanation and subsection structuring.

#### 3. Clarity

##### Recommendation:

The manuscript is readable but requires minor language and structural refinement. The authors should:

- Shorten overly long paragraphs.
- Improve sentence conciseness and coherence.
- Conduct minor English language editing to enhance clarity for international readers.

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### 4. Significance

Recommendation:

The significance of the study is high. To further enhance impact, the authors are advised to:

- Strengthen the policy implications section, particularly regarding practical implementation for governments, zakat institutions, and educational stakeholders.
- Clearly state how the findings can be generalized or adapted beyond the Indonesian context.
