### *Detailed Reviewer's Report*

The manuscript addresses an important and clinically relevant topic in prosthodontics—namely the role of soft and hard tissue landmarks in esthetics, function, and prosthetic rehabilitation. The subject matter is appropriate for a prosthodontic audience and aligns with contemporary interests in digital imaging and evidence-based treatment planning. However, while the content is conceptually sound, the manuscript requires **substantial revision** before it can be considered suitable for publication.

### Reviewer Report

#### Major Comments

##### 1. Citation and Referencing Errors

- Multiple citation–text mismatches are present.
- Disordered in-text citation numbering.
- Duplicate references and uncited references in the bibliography.
- Several references are incomplete or inconsistently formatted.

### 2. Lack of Scientific Rigor

- Numerous statements rely on vague phrases such as “studies indicate” without supporting data.
- Quantitative claims are presented without ranges, statistical parameters, or methodological details.
- No discussion of variability, reliability statistics, or population characteristics.

### 3. Structural and Organizational Issues

- Illogical flow of sections with premature methodological discussion.
- Fragmented presentation of occlusal plane determinants.
- Supporting structures and landmark descriptions are poorly sequenced.

### 4. Absence of Figures and Tables

- No illustrations are provided despite extensive discussion of anatomical landmarks and reference planes.
- Visual aids are essential for comprehension and clinical applicability.

### 5. Writing, Formatting, and Terminology

- Extensive spacing, typographical, and grammatical errors throughout.
- Missing spaces in the **title, abstract, and body text**
- Incorrect or obsolete terminology used in places.
- Use of “**piriformis papilla**” as a synonym for retromolar pad is **incorrect/obsolete**.
- Redundancy and repetition reduce conciseness and clarity.

## Minor Comments

1. Inconsistent use and definition of abbreviations.
2. Repetition of similar concepts across multiple sections.
3. Overemphasis on manual vs digital plotting compared to clinical synthesis.
4. Limited discussion of mandibular landmarks.
5. Digital workflow integration is mentioned but insufficiently explained.
6. Reference style should be standardized according to journal guidelines.
