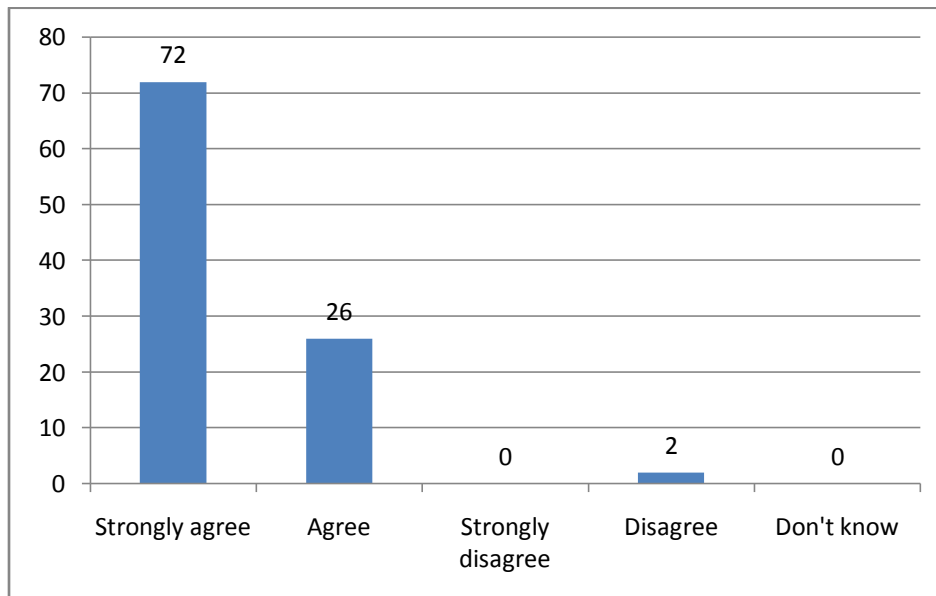
Abstract

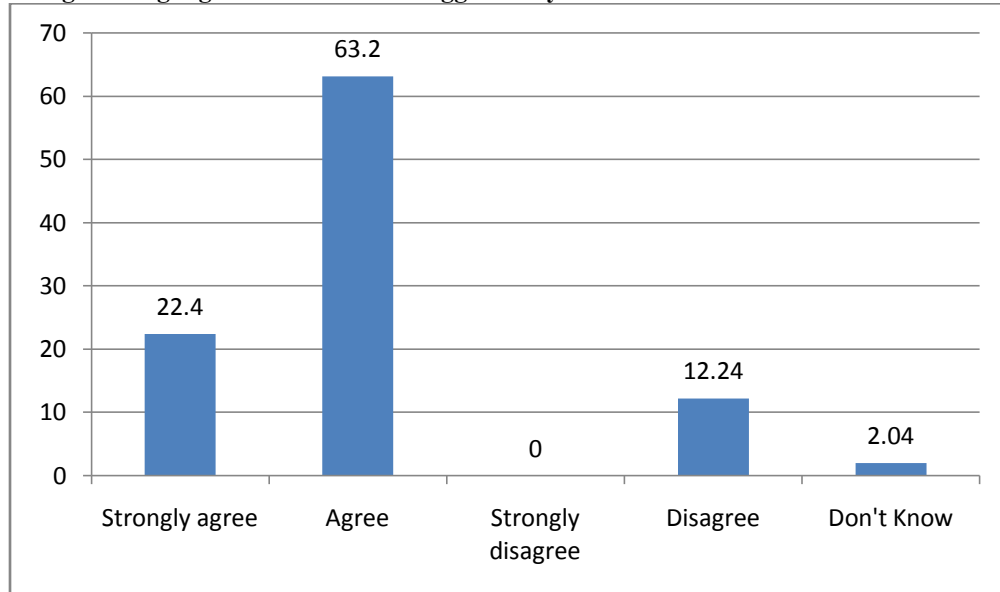
Graphical presentation of question number -1 based on percentage method

3. Two percent of teachers of English from the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh disagree that students require having command over tense, modals and preposition for acquisition of English language.

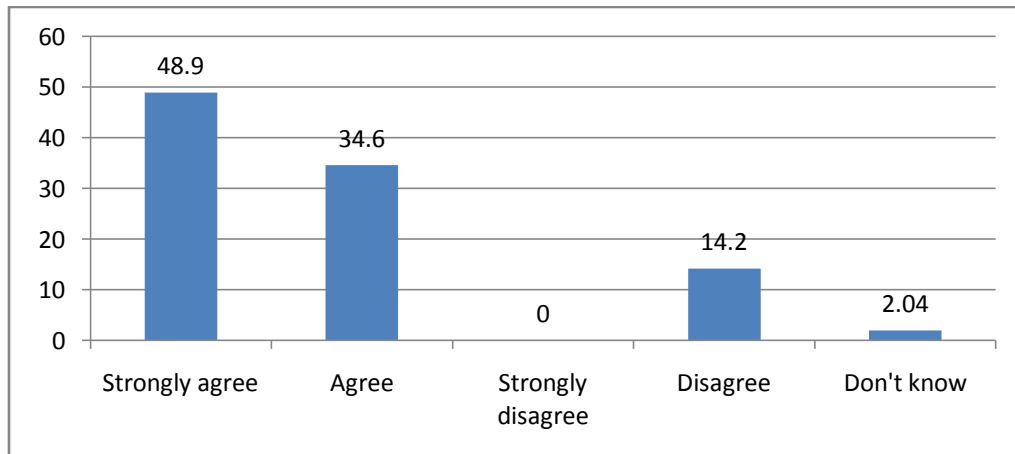
Q-2 Need of English language Grammar book suggested by teacher

4. Two point four percent of teachers of English from the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh don't know that students require having English language grammar book suggested by teachers.

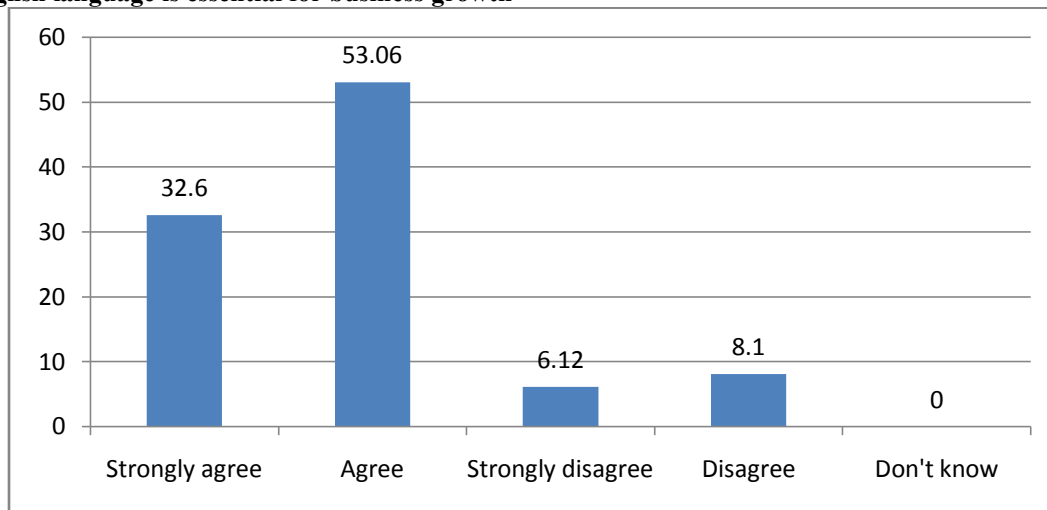
Q-3 Competence over English language is must to qualify an interview

- 4) Two point four percent of teachers of English from the Indian state of Madhya Pradesh don't know that students require having competence over English language is must to qualify an interview.

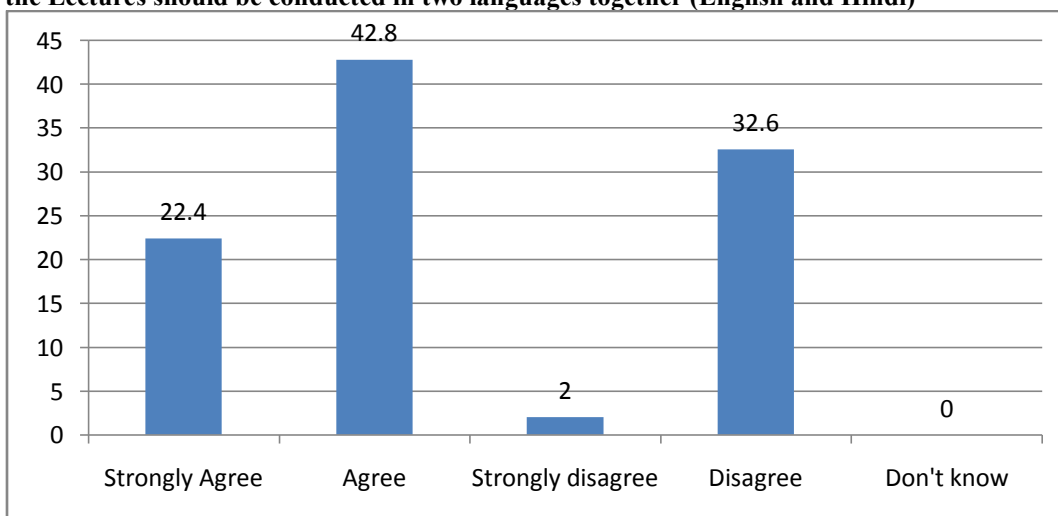
Q-4 English language is essential for business growth
